Parent Governor Vacancy

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that that we have a vacancy for one parent governor on the Governing Body and we invite nominations from parents who are interested in contributing to the effective governance and continuing success of the school.

The role of the Governing Body is to:

- set the aims and objectives for the school
- set the policies for achieving those aims and objectives
- set the targets for achieving those aims and objectives
- monitor and evaluate the progress the school is making towards achievement of its aims and objectives

The Governing Body is actively seeking to strengthen the skills within its membership and wishes to recruit and develop governors, who are able to work constructively in committees.

- All parents, other than those employed at the school for more than 500 hours per year or who are elected members of the Local Authority, are eligible to stand for election. This includes any person who is not the natural parent but has parental responsibility for, or who has care of, a pupil registered at the school (Education Act 1996, Section 576).
- Nominees must be proposed by a parent of a pupil registered at Durham Johnston School.
- A parent may nominate his/her partner.

In the event we receive more nominations than there are vacancies, then a ballot will be held and voting forms will be sent out to parents.

If no nominations are received, the vacancy will be appointed by the Governing Body.

The deadline for receipt of completed and signed nomination forms is by close of business on **Friday 19 January**.
