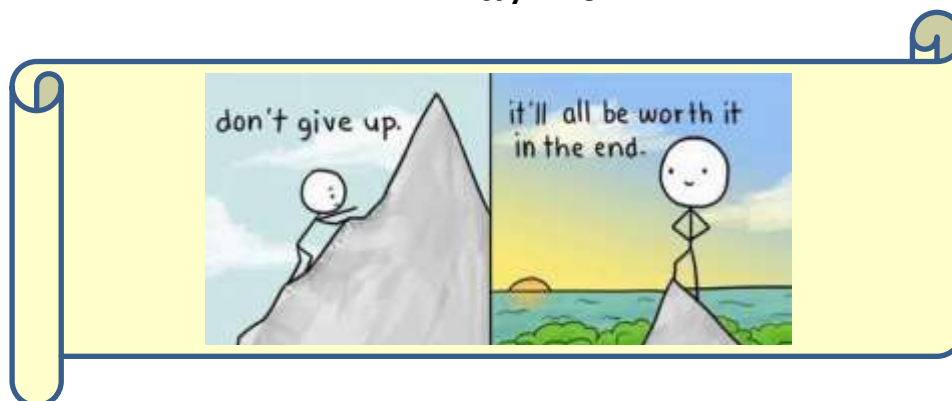


# THIS WEEK
