Nomination Form Guidance

All parents, other than those employed at the school for more than 500 hours per year or who are elected members of the Local Authority (LA) are eligible to stand for election.

This includes:

- parents of children attending nursery either full-time or part-time
- any person who is not the natural parent but has parental responsibility for, or who has care of a pupil registered at the school (Education Act 1996, Section 576)
- A parent may nominate his/her partner.

The completed and signed nomination form should be returned to school, marked for the attention of the Headteacher by **Friday 19 January**.

Where the number of nominations is equal to, or fewer than the places available, then no ballot will be necessary.

Should a ballot be required, each parent will receive a voting form issued to the eldest child in the family.

When the process has been finalised, the school will inform the parent body of the outcome via the Friday Bulletin which is published each week on the school's website.

School and Governor Support Service will write formally to all nominees confirming the outcome of the ballot.
