The Easter and Summer camp programme supports our '**Primary Performance Pathway**'. This aims to expose younger children to a wide range of sports activities, helping individuals to discover their passions and abilities in sports.

Primary Performance Pathway

Primary targets year 5 & 6 children in our local community and exposing them to as many sports as possible. Children who wish to participate need to have an active interest in PE, sports or games and, most importantly, the desire to try a wide range of new activities available at Durham Johnston.

Even at this early stage we will provide feedback to children, parents and carers, helping each child to discover what they enjoy and what they are good at.

Performance is directed at year 7 & 8 children who select a focus activity in which they wish to develop further with specialist coaching.

This 5 day programme takes place during the summer and children will spend 50% of each day concentrated on their focused activity. At its conclusion coaches will give more detailed feedback and demonstrate each individual's progress.

Pathway provides opportunities to advance identified talents further. The school can offer additional, specialist coaching, team and competitive activities, but also links to many clubs and organisations regionally.



- Our Sports Development Programme will be run by friendly, highly experienced and approachable staff in the PE department.
- All staff involved will have Enhanced DBS clearance.
- Teachers will lead, coach and encourage participants in a broad spectrum of sporting activities.
- Young sportspeople will have full access to our excellent facilities and equipment, whilst having fun finding out what they really enjoy and what they are good at.
- Coaching will reflect the breadth of sports and activities available in the school's current curriculum and extra-curricular programme.

Who Are the Camps for?

The Easter camp is specifically for pupils in years 5 and 6.
